## TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

The Miami Division Training Unit will be hosting a Tactically Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) Course at Camp Blanding for the Jacksonville District Office and the Gainesville Resident Office. **The course is open to 24 students any unfilled seats in the course will be opened up to any State & Local Law Enforcement Officer on a first come first served basis.**

This is an outstanding course of instruction that is more and more relevant today in law enforcement. Students attending the course will be issued an Individual First Aid Kit (IFAK) that includes a tourniquet, Quikclot, pressure bandages, and other items necessary to treat a gunshot wound and/or other massive hemorrhage injuries.

There is no cost for the course nor the IFAK, however any travel and/or lodging expenses are the responsibility of the individual's agency.
