1. **Dr. Jack Enter**- career police officer, served as a professor and administrator as well as the former Director of Information and Education for the Governor's Criminal Justice Coordinating Council (GA). Dr. Enter is also an author, speaker and teacher to police organizations around the world.
2. **Robert Trevino**- US Army (retired) operational member of a United States Army Special Missions Unit under the United States Army Special Operations Command; awards and decorations include the Silver Star, the Legion of Merit, 5 Bronze Stars (2 for Valor). Mr. Trevino has extensive leadership experience in a variety of high stress/high threat environments. Mr. Trevino has also authored a book on leadership.

3. **Charles "Sid" Heal**- career police officer retired USMC with service in more than 20 countries and four combat tours. Mr. Heal has earned a Master's of Public Administration, a Master's of Science in Management; he is recognized as an expert in a variety of topics relative to law enforcement. Additionally, Mr. Heal has extensive practical experience leading high risk projects both nationally and internationally, as well as authoring several books.
4. **Steve Ijames**- career police officer, retired Assistant Chief Springfield MO; MPA; created and developed curriculum/procedure for a variety of law enforcement subjects to include the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) and the National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA); On behalf of the US Department of State and the IACP, Mr. Ijames has provided law enforcement training to agencies throughout the United States, Canada and in 33 countries.
