## Keynote Speaker

Dr. Timothy P. Condon, Deputy Director of the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) will serve as this year's keynote speaker, and his keynote address will focus on addiction as a brain disease.

Dr. Condon was appointed as Deputy Director of the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) in 2003. Dr. Condon has held a number of prominent science policy positions at NIDA since he arrived in 1992. He served as the Chief of the Science Policy Branch and the Acting Deputy Director of the Office of Science Policy and Communications (OSPC) until 1996 when he was appointed NIDA's first Associate Director for Science Policy, as well as the Director of OSPC.

Dr. Condon is the author of numerous scientific and science policy reports. Dr. Condon has served on a number of Federal Task Forces and Committees, received numerous awards and honors for his leadership in setting science policy standards, and serves as a member of several professional organizations.
