PRIVACY ACT NOTICE

Providing this information is voluntary. Authorities for the collection of this information are found in 5 U.S.C. Part II (Civil Service Functions and Responsibilities) and Part III (Employees). The principal purposes for which the information will be used are to evaluate your qualifications and suitability for employment at the DEA and to ensure the accuracy of agency records. The information may be disclosed to employees of the U.S. Department of Justice who have a need to know the information for the performance of their duties, and to appropriate Federal, State, or local agencies responsible for investigating, prosecuting, enforcing, or implementing a statute, rule, regulation, or order, when DEA becomes aware of an indication of a violation or potential violation of civil or criminal law or regulation.
